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European University Alliances



Scope and objectives

- Key initiative to achieve the EEA and the transformation of HE
- Key role in other EU strategies
- Transnational extensive deep long-term institutional cooperation based on common values and principles
- Mobilizing all 4 missions of HEIs (education, research, innovation, service to society)
- Currently 44 Alliances (340 HEIs from 31 countries)
- Target: 60 Alliances by mid-2024

Practical information – Call 2023

- 2 topics – intensification of prior cooperation + development of new cooperation
- News:
 - HEIs from Western Balkan as full partners
 - Award of the Seal of Excellence
- Total available budget: 384 mil euros (grant per Alliances approx. 3 -14 mil)

- Boosting innovation through cooperation between HE, VET and broader socio-economic environment, including research
- Talent and skills development (including green and digital skills)

Virtual Exchanges in Higher education and Youth

Scope and objectives

- International and cross-cultural education without physical mobility
- Aims:
 - Intercultural dialogue with 3rd countries not associated to the Programme
 - Enhancing critical thinking, media literacy, digital and soft skills
 - Promoting citizenship and common values
 - Various types of online exchanges (discussions, open online courses,...)

Practical information – Call 2023

- Exchanges moderated by trained facilitator
- Ensuring safety and open access for all interested participants
- Minimum 4 organizations from 4 countries (2 + 2 from the same region)
 - Eligible regions: 1,2,3,4,9 (geographical priorities and targets)
- Duration: 3 years
- Max. grant: 500 000 EUR (200 per participant \rightarrow max. grant = 2500 participants)
- Deadline: April 2023
