Focus on the Erasmus+ centralised actions in higher education and cooperation with partner countries

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## **Erasmus Mundus Design Measures**

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- a short duration grant to support institutions in the set-up of a new joint Master programme in Europe (and beyond)
- mono-beneficiary project

at application stage, the beneficiary should identify the participating organisations

- fixed duration of 15 months
- fixed single lump sum contribution of € 55.000

costs linked to the activities necessary to set up the new joint master programme (staff, travel, subsistance cost, accreditation)



## What is expected at the end of the project?

- joint programme design and procedures
- joint administrative and financial management
- common services offered to students
- joint **promotion** and dissemination
- a draft joint Partnership and Student Agreement

PA covering all academic, operational, administrative and financial aspects related to the implementation

 planned activities to be described under Part B of the application form and in a single work package



## What is expected at the end of the project?

- joint degree policy and launch of accreditation process
- the programme should adhere to the Standards for Quality Assurance of Joint Programmes in the EHEA

It is encouraged to at least launch any accreditation/evaluation process before the end of the project, and explore the opportunities offered by the European Approach for Quality Assurance of Joint Programmes (if national legislation allows)

- Register your organization, PIC number
- Download template Part B (project description + annexes) 40 pages only 1 annex: detailed budget table – one fixed lump sum 1 work package
- Part A and Part C (administrative forms) to be completed directly on the Portal
- <u>F&TP online manual and User Guide of the Submission System</u>
- <u>EACEA\_EPLUS\_ERASMUS\_MUNDUS@ec.europa.eu</u>



## Award criteria

CRITERIA	POINTS
Relevance	40
Quality of the project design and implementation	20
Quality of the partnership and cooperation arrangements	20
Impact	20
Maximum	100
Treshold	60

- in case of the same result: **relevance**, then **impact**
- peer review by **2 independent external experts**: assess each proposal



## Relevance (40)

#### Background, general objective, aims of the project

• and their relevance to the EMDM

#### Needs analysis and specific objective

- rationale for the design of a MA programme
- contribution to the development of new partnerships and potential to involve Erasmus Mundus

underrepresented (a) EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme, and/or (b)

institutions from these countries, and/or (c) thematic areas

#### Complementarity with other actions and innovation

- project ambition compared to the offer of existing MA programmes
- contribution to the attractiveness of the EHEA



## Quality of the project design & implementation (20)

#### **Concept and methodology**

• adequacy and feasibility of the planned activities to achieve the objectives and expected outcomes

#### Project management, quality assurance and monitoring and evaluation strategy

- measures foreseen to ensure that the project implementation is of high quality and completed in time
- planned steps to launch an accreditation/evaluation process for the proposed Master course, if possible taking advantage of the opportunities offered by the European Approach for Quality Assurance of Joint Programmes

#### Project teams, staff and experts

- foreseen operational resources (including participating organisations) in relation to the planned activities and outcomes
- definition of roles and distribution of tasks in the project team



## Quality of the partnership & cooperation arrangements (20)

#### **Consortium set-up**

- expected role of the participating organisations. Their contribution to the implementation of the project, and the design of the master programme
- rationale of their participation, added value and complementarity



## Impact

#### Impact and ambition

• expected impact and ambition of the new EMDM project

#### Communication, dissemination and visibility

 activities foreseen for the promotion and dissemination of the new Master programme and project outcomes

#### Sustainability and continuation

 envisaged steps to successfully launch/implement the new Master programme (including institutional endorsement) and foreseen measures to ensure its sustainability (including identification of possible sources of funding)
